**TIMETABLE OF APPLICATION PROCESS, ELIGIBILITY
REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION CRITERIA**

Timetable for the Application Process:

April 7, 2015: Application Process Opens

Students, who reside in the First Congressional District of New Mexico and meet the eligibility criteria, may begin submitting application materials to request a Congressional Nomination for a Service Academy. You may request a nomination packet at any time up to the deadline. However, the earlier you begin the process of applying and gathering the required materials, the better.

October 9, 2015: Nomination Application Deadline

ALL applications and required materials **MUST** be submitted by **5:30pm October 9, 2015. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Only electronic submission will be accepted. The only exceptions to this are SAT/ACT scores and official transcripts; these may be submitted via sealed envelope to the district office. Send application packets to:

Applicants are responsible for making sure their files are complete. If you do not submit the required information by the above deadline, your application will not be considered.

November 9, 2015: Interviews by Selection Panel

The Service Academy Selection Panel will interview all applicants who qualify for a nomination.

Mid-December 2015: Announcement of Nominees

The nominations will be made and all nominees will be notified.

February 2016: Offers of Appointment from Academies

Nominations by U.S. Congresswoman Michelle Lujan Grisham do not automatically result in selection by the Military Service Academies. **Selection for appointment to each Academy is ultimately decided upon by the academies.**

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements as of July 1 of the year of admission to the Academy:

- I. Age:** The student must be between 17 and 22 years of age.
- II. Citizenship:** Applicant must be a United States Citizen by November 1 of the application year.
- III. Marital Status:** Must be unmarried, not pregnant and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.
- IV. Domicile:** Candidate must reside in the 1st Congressional District of New Mexico

Selection Criteria

Nominations from U.S. Congresswoman Michelle Lujan Grisham are based on a “whole person” evaluation. Applicants are considered for nomination based upon four levels of criteria:

- I. Scholarship:** Evaluation of academic records will include the applicant’s grade point average, SAT/ACT scores, class ranking, student’s willingness to embrace academic challenges, and, if applicable, any college records.
- II. Leadership:** Consideration will be made based on the student’s leadership experience and potential command ability. The consideration of this qualification will be based upon the applicant’s record of extracurricular activities. Quality of involvement is stressed over the number of activities.
- III. Character/Motivation:** Consideration of the motivation and desire of applicants to attend a service academy is based upon the essay submitted by the applicant, their recommendation, and their interview before the Academy Nominee Selection Board.
- IV. Competitiveness:** The final consideration of an applicant for a nomination is comparative in nature, appraising each applicant’s attributes against all others who are applying.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a nomination, a student must read all guidelines carefully and complete all of the steps below prior to **October 9, 2015**. Please send items 1-6 to LujanGrishamAcademySubmissions@mail.house.gov. Please send all documents as a **single PDF document**. Do not email items individually. **Only PDFs will be accepted**. Use the included checklist as a coversheet when you submit your application packet. Once you have sent the documents call and verify that they have been received.

All completed applications must be received by **October 9, 2015**. **No exceptions will be made.**

Materials:

- 1. Letter Requesting Nomination** – Submit a letter to U.S. Congresswoman Michelle Lujan Grisham requesting a nomination. This must be written in a formal business format.
- 2. Application for Nomination** - Return the completed Application for Nomination.
- 3. Resume** – Provide a detailed listing of your academic, community service, extracurricular activities, athletic activities, and any other notable accomplishments.
- 4. Essay** – Compose an essay of no more than 500 words, which provides insight into why you desire to attend a Service Academy and why you would be a good candidate for admission. **This essay must be separate and distinct from your letter.**
- 5. Photo** – Attach a recent photo to your completed application. Photos must be color portraits. Make sure the photo is tasteful and professional (no selfies, etc.).
- 6. Letters of Recommendation** – Submit three letters of recommendation from individuals unrelated to you, who can assess your intellect, character, and suitability for military service. **One** from a teacher, principal, school administrator, guidance counselor, or academic dean with accompanying recommendation form; **one** from an employer or extracurricular faculty advisor; and **one** from a person of your choice. You want these letters to appear

professional and include contact information for the individual writing them. Academic and professional letters must be on official school/business letterhead. Again, submit as a PDF only—no word documents.

7. **Official Transcripts** – Submit a copy of your official transcripts to be sent directly from your high school (or college) to the above address.
8. **Standardized Test Results** – Have your scores sent directly from the testing services to the above address. If your standardized test score is notated on your transcript that is sufficient. We will accept test results past the October 9th deadline provided that they are postmarked on or before that date.



MILITARY SERVICE ACADEMY INFORMATION

The President of the United States, Vice President, Members of Congress and some other agencies and organizations have the authority to nominate persons for admission to a Service Academy.

Applicants should direct any questions regarding the admissions process for a particular Academy to the Academy's Admissions office. Applicants are responsible for initiating a pre-candidate file at each Academy to which they are seeking a nomination. Contact information for each of the academies is listed below.

- Please make sure that you have your **Official Transcripts, School Disciplinary file (if applicable)**, and all **Standardized Test Results** sent directly to our office.
